Credit Hours: 120 total credit hours with overall GPA of at least 2.0 and Sociology GPA of at least 2.0.

- A minimum of 10 (32 semester hours) Sociology courses with a "C" or better. Grades lower than a C will not count in the completion of the major – Gen Ed courses excluded. The Department of Sociology has a 3 attempt rule for all courses. Students may only attempt a course 3 times; including, Drop, Withdraw, and grade replacements of "D" or "F."
- At least 3 hours designated writing intensive (W) course within the major.
- Students are required to have a Minor or Double Major included in the total 120 credit hours.
- Students must demonstrate competence at the 1202 level in a language; competence can be demonstrated by transfer courses, placement exam, 3 or more years of the same foreign language in high school, or courses at UNC Charlotte.
