

CONCENTRATION IN SOCIOLOGY

Students can, if desired, complete a concentration in one of three substantive areas as part of the B.A. degree. The three areas are: Sociological Social Psychology; Social Problems and Policy; and Organizations, Occupations, and Work.

Each concentration will require a total of four (4) courses, in which one is a required course for the specific concentration and the other three courses are selected from an approved list of electives for the specific concentration. A grade of **C** or above must be earned in the required course and a **GPA of 2.5 must be earned in the concentration**. These courses will not add to the total number of hours required for the major, but will count toward the elective hours already required for the major.
